Frequently Asked Questions

Does my child qualify for your VPK or preschool?

- If your child is 4 years old by September 1, 2023 they qualify for the FREE Florida VPK program!
- If your child is 3 years old by September 1, 2023, they qualify for our tuition-based 3-year-old program!

What hourly preschool options are available?

We have different options to fit your child's educational needs!

- We offer half-day and full-day options.
- VPK hours (free hours provided by the state of Florida) are 8:00am - 12:00pm, Monday - Thursday. If you are enrolling in VPK, your child must attend during these hours and follow the state attendance guidelines to qualify for the program.
- 3-year-old tuition based students can opt for a 2, 3, or 4 day option.
- We also provide an optional Fun Friday program from 8:00am – 1:30pm for an additional fee.

Who can attend your preschool?

- Our preschool is open to our community and we are happy to serve the Maitland/Altamonte Springs area...and beyond!
- You do not have to be a member of our church to attend our preschool. However, please be aware that we are a Christ-centered classroom. Our curriculum, discipline, and social skills will be taught from a Biblical perspective.
- If you have concerns about any special needs your child might have, please contact the director to see if King of Kings is able to provide what is needed for your child.

How many students will be in each classroom?

- We are a small preschool and will have no more than 11 students in a classroom. This allows the teacher work with each child and meet their individual needs.
- The 3 and 4-year-old classes are in a combined classroom. This is to the benefit of both age groups and is a blessing of a multi-age classroom!

Does my child need to be potty-trained to attend?

- Yes! Children must be completely toilet-trained and be able to perform bathroom tasks independently before joining our classroom. We have two bathroom facilities in our classroom.

What does a daily schedule look like?

- The mornings begin with a morning meeting, story, and Bible time. This is a wonderful way for us to start our day together!
- Morning hours include scheduled plan & play time, snack, table time, circle time, small group, recess, and music/art/gym. We always conclude our school day with prayer.
- Students who choose the half-day option are dismissed at noon. Students who are staying for the full-day option go outside for a bonus recess, enjoy lunch together, and settle down for a quiet rest time. After rest time, the students have free choice playtime until they go home.

What curriculum do you use?

- We use a curriculum called High Scope. This curriculum provides child-led free-play planning and options. We provide a variety of toys and learning materials to create a rich, imaginative environment where the children can nurture their creative minds and have multiple opportunities to practice social skills. We also organize our activities around a letter-of-the-week program that provides literacy, sensory, and hands-on activities that introduce the students to letter and number concepts.

Is there a uniform/dress code?

- Tops: red, black, or white polos or plain t-shirts.
- Bottoms: khaki, black, or navy pants, shorts, or skirts.
- These items can be found at Walmart, Target, The Children's Place, or other stores.

How do I pay my tuition bill?

- We use a program called Gradelink/PaySimple. Once your child is enrolled, we will add you to the program and you can view and pay your bill online.

This all sounds great! How can I register my child at King of Kings Lutheran Preschool?

- Request a tour of our classroom/campus! You will be able to meet the teacher/director and ask any additional questions you may have.
- Complete and submit the application form (obtained after the tour), along with the other forms in the enrollment packet that require a signature.
- Submit a copy of your child's birth certificate, current immunization record, and physical record.
- Submit your VPK Certificate of Eligibility (VPK students only)
 - Visit familyservices.floridaearlylearning.com/ and click on the VPK link. From here you can fill out your child's information (and upload proof of residency and proof of age) to obtain their Certificate of Eligibility.
